Message from Richard

Today's Bible reading is Psalm 119 vv 129 - 136

Psalm 119 verse 129 begins with, 'Your statutes are wonderful.' which made me wonder the extent to which we find the word of God wonderful. Do we get excited about it and about what God is saying to you and me through it?

This is a deep appreciation for the wisdom and beauty in God's word. I am sure many people have a Bible on a shelf or hidden away in a cupboard. For them it is just another book. But for the Christian, this book is supernatural.

I have been reading books by Simon Tolkien recently, grandson of J. R. R. Tolkien. There were parts of those books where it would have been helpful to have had the author with me to explain some of the text. When I open the pages of the Bible I do have the Author with me and I can ask the Author to help me understand it. What is more wonderful is that he opens understanding in a way that is right for me.

Wherever you are in your Christian walk, God can reveal his word at a level that is right for you. I often think of the Bible as being like an onion. There are layers to peel off and I believe he wants us to peel layers off and go even deeper into his word. A small group of us meet on a Thursday morning on zoom to discuss passages from the Bible. Time and time again we can look at familiar passages and yet still find things we hadn't realised or thought about. Please come and join us! If we are serious about deepening our relationship with God, then one way is to delve further into His word and peel off some of the layers!
